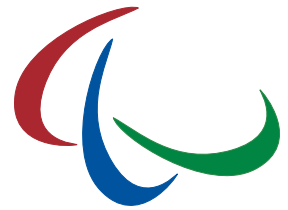

Allocation of Qualification Slots

The qualification slot is allocated to the individual athlete, not to the NPC.



Maximum Quota Allocation per NPC

An NPC may be allocated a maximum of three (3) qualification slots per individual event.

An NPC may be allocated a slot to compete in:

- a maximum of five (5) qualification slots per men's team events with one (1) team per event and/or
- a maximum of three (3) qualification slots per women's team events with one (1) team per event.

Each men's team event will comprise a minimum of six (6) and a maximum of sixteen (16) teams of at least two (2) qualified male athletes selected at the discretion of the International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF).

Each women's team event will comprise a minimum of six (6) and a maximum of sixteen (16) teams of at least two (2) qualified female athletes selected at the discretion of ITTF.

ITTF will confirm in writing to the NPCs the final competition formats for team events (i.e. tournament sizes) no later than 23 April 2016.

Athlete Eligibility

To be eligible for selection by an NPC, athletes must:

- be ranked on the ITTF Para Table Tennis (PTT) World Rating List closing 31 December 2015;
- meet the requirements of the ITTF Tournament Credit System (1 January 2014 to 31 December 2015);
- be internationally classified with a 'Confirmed' sport class status.

Maximum Entry per NPC

An NPC can enter a maximum of three (3) eligible athletes per individual event.

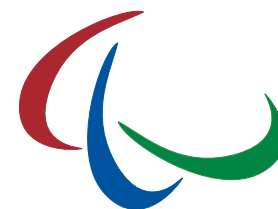
An NPC can enter a maximum of one (1) eligible team per team event, comprising a minimum of two (2) and a maximum of three (3) eligible athletes entered in individual events.



QUALIFICATION SYSTEM

Qualification slots will be allocated as follows:

TIMELINE

1 October 2014	Start of the period for athletes to attain performances to be recorded on the ITTF PTT Male and Female World Rating Lists
2015, tbd	ITTF PTT Regional Championships Africa
7-14 August 2015	Para Panamerican Games, Toronto, Canada
2015, tbd	ITTF PTT Regional Championships Asia
2015, tbd	ITTF PTT Regional Championships Europe
2015, tbd	ITTF Regional Championships Oceania
31 December 2015	End of the period for athletes to attain performances to be recorded on the ITTF PTT Male and Female World Rating Lists
15 January 2016	ITTF sends to NPCs the players selected from the ITTF PTT Regional Championships and from the ITTF PTT Male and Female World Rating List allocations and the proposed team compositions
15 January 2016	Start of Bipartite Commission Invitation application process
15 February 2016	NPCs confirm in writing to ITTF the acceptance/rejection of the Regional Championships and World Rating Lists selections and the team composition proposals
15 February 2016	Deadline to submit Bipartite Commission Invitation applications to ITTF
12 March 2016	ITTF confirms in writing to the NPCs the allocation of all qualification slots and team compositions
12 March 2016	ITTF confirms in writing the awarding of Bipartite Commission Invitation slots
12 March 2016	ITTF confirms in writing to the NPCs the final competition formats for team events
26 March 2016	NPCs confirm in writing the use of allocated qualification slots
9 April 2016	ITTF confirms in writing the reallocation of unused qualification slots
23 April 2016	NPCs confirm in writing to ITTF the use of reallocated qualification slots



30 April 2016	Deadline for Rio 2016 Organising Committee to receive accreditation application forms submitted by NPCs (“Accreditation Long List”)
15 August 2016	Deadline for Rio 2016 Organising Committee to receive sport entry forms submitted by NPCs

CONFIRMATION PROCESS OF ALLOCATED SLOTS

By March 2016 each qualified NPC must confirm to ITTF in writing (email is accepted) the number of qualification slots for selected players which they will use. NPCs that have not replied by this date will have lost their qualification slots, and the ITTF may reallocate these slots.

By 9 April 2016 ITTF will confirm in writing the reallocation of all unused qualification slots.

By 23 April 2016 it is officially declared that the respective NPCs will use the allocated slots for the Rio 2016 Paralympic Games. Any NPC that does not use its allocated slots may be subject to sanctions by IPC and ITTF.

REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUALIFICATION SLOTS

Any qualification slots that are not used by the respective NPC will be reallocated as follows:

Slots allocated at the 2015 ITTF PTT Regional Championships

Any qualification slots obtained through the individual qualification method at a 2015 ITTF PTT Regional Championships and not used by the respective NPC will be reallocated to the next highest rated athlete(s) from that respective competition.

Slots allocated through the ITTF PTT World Rating Lists Allocation Method

Any qualification slots that are not used by an NPC will be reallocated by the ITTF to the next highest rated athlete on the ITTF PTT Male and Female World Rating Lists closing 31 December 2015.
